

“ We are the **aroma of Christ** to God among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.”

2 Corinthians 2:15

God created us and the world around us so that He could reveal Himself to us. We **see** what God shows us, we **hear** what He speaks to us. We **feel** what He offers to us to touch. God appeals to our sense of **taste**. In the above passage Paul compares the lives of people with what can be smelled.

When Paul and his companions are with people who despise God, the truth to which Paul bears witness reveals that these people are spiritually dead. When Paul is with people who have been regenerated by the Word and inspired to love God, the Gospel that Paul proclaims to confirm and sustain their faith reveals that these people are alive *and smell of the fragrance that is pleasing to God.*

*PRAY: Dear Lord, Give us sincere hearts to look honestly at ourselves, so we may never take Your grace for granted, and that we might be a sweet aroma of grace to others.
In Your Holy Name we pray. Amen.*



GRAMMY'S THRIFT STORE

Grammy's Thrift Store, located in Lake Elsinore, CA provides the community's homeless and low-income persons with hot meals and clothing. The hot meals are served on the last Sunday evening of each month by volunteers from the community.


Grammy's Thrift Store also gives clothing, household furnishings, beds, books, and toys to women and their children who are of low income and are moving into our community from surrounding homeless and/or battered women shelters through Housing Services.

For the homeless and impoverished families, Grammy's furnishes four full outfits for each person consisting of pants, dress, skirt, shorts, shirts, undergarments, and one pair of shoes. They also supply business attire for those interviewing and looking for work. Grammy's also supplies hygiene products and camping items.

We pray, in whatever way the Lord supplies—whether it's volunteer work, monetary donations, or supplying items in need—that, in His loving care, Jesus will meet all our needs.
